MySQL is the popular open source database which can be used with PHP and ASP to provide the backend for many forums, blogs, bulletin boards, guestbooks, photos and other web applications.

Our MySQL service supports the latest version - MySQL Enterprise Server v5 using certified 64-bit binaries to provide our customers' applications with an ultra-fast database service.



At the same time, we launched our Microsoft SQL 2005 service, also running the latest 64-bit technology to offer customer applications the greatest performance available.

As requested by Microsoft SQL customers, we also included free access to myLittleAdmin and myLittleBackup - the leading web based management and backup/restore tools for Microsoft SQL 2005.

In April, we completed the next round of upgrades and introduced a host of great new features:

For Web hosting customers, statistics login details were standardised, new file types and page extensions could be tracked and we also included new statistics e-mail reporting tools.

We also doubled the memory in our Windows 2003 web servers and also in our e-mail servers to ensure customer services remain at peak performance. We also migrated to network managed power for enhanced power monitoring.

Possibly the best upgrade in April was the huge increase in bandwidth we added to all customer web hosting plans. The Small Business web hosting plan now includes 400% more bandwidth than ever before!
