## **New! Thawte 123 Certificates**

Working in exactly the same way as Thawte Web server certificates to protect data submitted via an online form or shopping cart, the new SSL 123 certificates can be issued quickly whilst still providing the industry standard of 128-bit encryption.

All SSL 123 certificates carry the Thawte hallmark of trust and have the option of displaying the site seal with Thawte's dynamic date stamp. In addition to the gold padlock, the Thawte date stamp offers visitors extra verification that the certificate belongs to the web site it is being displayed on.

Thawte secure (SSL) certificates are used to protect shopping carts and e-commerce web sites throughout the world. As a Root Certification Authority (not reliant on another company to provide the certificate services) Thawte is recognised as one of the most trusted brands in digital security.

### Comparing Thawte Certificates:

There are two differences between the certificates. The first is in the level of verification when applying for the certificate and subsequent renewals and the second is in the details which appear when the certificate details are checked (by double clicking on the gold padlock).

With **SSL 123 certificates**, the domain name is checked to ensure it has been registered and that you have authorised the purchase of a SSL certificate. If these checks are successful, the certificate is issued straightaway.

When a visitor clicks on the gold padlock for a SSL 123 certificate, the pop-up window will list the owner in the form of the domain name, e.g. www.yourname.co.uk.

When applying for a **SSL Web server certificate**, Thawte make additional checks on your business or individual application. Typically this will include cross-referencing the domain name owner details with Companies House (for Limited companies) and/or with utility bills or a bank statement. A final check for SSL Web server certificates is a telephone call to the named contact on the application, to ensure the purchase of the SSL certificate has been authorised.

When a visitor clicks on the gold padlock for a SSL Web server certificate, the pop-up window will list the domain name and also the company name (where applicable).

As well as virus scanning through two, independent scanners, AVAS also analyses e-mails using five levels of spam detection to assess the probability that an e-mail contains spam content.
