

▶ **New Offices Planned for Summer 2006**

At Net Energy Internet, we are pleased to announce a forthcoming expansion. Since our founding in 1997, we have been located at offices in Newton Abbot and the time has come for us to move to larger premises.

Due to the nature of our company, it has been a lengthy process to find suitable premises, however in late 2005 we managed to find them in the form of the newly completed Newton Centre on the Matford Business Park in Exeter, approximately 15 miles north of our Newton Abbot offices.

The Newton Centre comprises of five terraced units, built from the ground up by ROK Developments. The new units are currently in a shell specification and were only finished in the last few weeks.

The ground floor of our unit (Unit 5) has over three times the amount of floor space that we currently have in Newton Abbot. As part of the interior fit-out, we are also creating a first floor, taking the total floor space to over seven times the size of our current offices. Also included with our unit is a palisade fenced compound, nearly the same size as the entire ground floor.

With the building structure completed, work has now started on the fit-out. The building is being divided into four suites and custom fitted to our exact specification. Due to the scale of the building, we will only be taking one suite, however will be managing the fit-out process for the whole building.

This is a major milestone for us at Net Energy Internet. In our suite, not only will we have approximately twice the floor space that we currently have, but we will be in a better position to take advantage of Exeter's improved communications infrastructure and deliver some exciting new services in the coming months and years.

We will be documenting the progress of the fit-out and have created an area on our website for customers to view pictures of the building as it reaches each stage.

▶ **.EU Launch Preparations**

With only seven days to go until the land rush launch of the new .eu domain name extension, now is the time to choose which .eu domain name(s) you would like to register.

.eu domain names are open to both business and personal applications and are issued on a first come, first served basis.

There's no limit to the number of .eu domain names that one person or company can register, however you must have a postal address in a country in Europe to qualify for .eu registrations.

.eu is the new top level 'country code' extension for Europe. By the end of the first week in April, it's estimated that 1.5 million .eu domain names will have been registered. Source: Network Solutions Inc.

Popular first names, such as john.eu, will be among the first to be registered, but why not submit an application for your family name that can be used in memorable e-mail addresses, e.g. julie@smith.eu, simon@smith.eu.

If you're interested in registering .eu domain names to sell, it's worth avoiding trademarked or competitor's names and applying for common or generic words and phrases. There are lots of combinations to choose from!

You don't even need to register an English spelling. Remember, .eu is available to all countries in Europe, so words written in French, Spanish, Italian, Swedish, Czech, Hungarian, Lithuanian, Slovakian and more, are valid applications for .eu domain names.

Following on the domain name theme, we would just like to remind everyone that the date on our domain name renewal invoices applies to the renewal date listed at the registry.

We offer a seven day credit extension on all renewals, however do not renew a domain name at the registry until we have received your payment.

Although it is possible to renew a domain name once the expiry date has passed, you may find that the registry suspends your domain name without warning. In this instance, your website and/or e-mail may be offline between the renewal date and when we receive your payment.

To ensure that we can renew your domain name on time, please use the 'Order Date' shown on your invoice as a guide to the renewal date at the registry.
